




Assembly Instructions


Please use gloves for assembly.








Remove the protective foam covers from the brackets of the seat base. Position the backrest carefully between the brackets. Insert all 4 bolts (2 on each side) and bring to a loose fit with the hex wrench. Tighten each bolt simultaneously until all are snug.




Remove the red protective cap on the top of the base if present. Insert the hydraulic lift cylinder into the center of the base




Install the side covers and tighten the bolts to secure them in place. (Place the cover designated "R" on the side of the chair with the lever.)




Place the telescoping cover over the hydraulic lift cylinder.



Rest the chair on the seat back. Remove the 4 pre-mounted bolts and washers from the underside.



Remove the pre-assembled bolts and washer from the seat back with the hex wrench.



Align the multi-tilt control unit with the holes on the underside of the chair, making sure the "front" arrow is pointing towards the front of the chair. Insert the bolts and washers and tighten all bolts simultaneously.



Insert top of the hydraulic lift cylinder into the mounting hole on the control unit, then place the chair upright.


Adjustable Functions

For illustration only. Functions may vary.



Tilt and lock lever is located on the opposite side of the chair. Twist lever down to lock at desired angle. Twist lever up and lean back to disengage the tilt lock.

Important Safety Information

Recommended weight load should not exceed 350lbs (158kg). The chair should only be used for normal seating. Do not use the chair in any potentially dangerous positions. Please exercise caution when using the maximum reclining and tilt position to avoid any injuries.

- DO NOT have more than one person on the seat.
- DO NOT sit on the edge of the seat.
- DO NOT stand on the seat.
- DO NOT play with the reclining mechanism
- DO NOT exceed reclining limits.
